VCE Unit 1 – VCE DRAMA

Time Allocation

This unit of work will consist of approximately 100 hours of which at least 50 hours will be class time. **To complete this unit of work satisfactorily, students must complete each of the following learning outcomes.**

Learning Outcomes

Outcome 1

On completion of this unit the student should be able to devise and document solo and/or ensemble drama work/s based on experiences and/or stories.

Outcome 2

On completion of this unit the student should be able to perform a devised drama work/s to an audience.

Outcome 3

On completion of this unit the student should be able to analyse the development and performance to an audience of their non-naturalistic devised work.

Outcome 4

On completion of this unit the student should be able to analyse the portrayal of stories and characters in a drama performance by professional or other drama practitioners.

Assessment Tasks

1. MINI ENSEMBLE PERFORMANCE

The student is required to develop and present character/s within a non-naturalistic ensemble performance.

Weighting: This task is worth 10% of the overall grade **Time allocated to task:** 5 periods

2. ENSEMBLE PERFORMANCE

The student is required to develop and present character/s within a non-naturalistic ensemble performance.

Weighting: This task is worth 40% of the overall grade **Time allocated to task:** 30 periods

Due: Term 2, Week 7

3. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

The student is required to analyse and evaluate a non-naturalistic performance selected from the prescribed playlist.

Weighting: This task is worth 25% of the overall grade **Time allocated to task:** 5 periods

4. ENSEMBLE REVIEW EXAMINATION

The student is required to analyse play-making techniques used to construct and present ensemble works including the work created for Outcomes 1 & 2

Weighting: This task is worth 25% of the overall grade **Time allocated to task:** 90 minutes
