Ensemble performance

Time Allocation

This unit of work will consist of approximately 100 hours of which at least 50 hours will be class time. **To complete this unit of work satisfactorily, students must complete each of the following learning outcomes.**

Learning Outcomes

Outcome 1

On completion of this outcome the student should be able to develop and present character/s within a devised non-naturalistic ensemble performance.

Outcome 2

On completion of this outcome the student should be able to analyse the use of processes, techniques and skills to create and present a devised ensemble performance.

Outcome 3

On completion of this outcome the student should be able to analyse and evaluate a non-naturalistic performance.

Assessment Tasks

1. Performance Review (Outcome 3)

The student is required to analyse and evaluate a non-naturalistic performance selected from the prescribed playlist.

Weighting: This task is worth 15% (/20) of the overall semester grade

Time allocated to task: 6 periods

Due: Term 1, Week 9

2 Ensemble Performance (Outcome 1)

The student is required to develop and present character/s within a non-naturalistic ensemble performance.

Weighting: This task is worth 70% (/80) of the overall semester grade

Time allocated to task: 30 periods

Due: Term 2, Week 6

3 Ensemble Review (Outcome 2)

The student is required to analyse play-making techniques used to construct and present ensemble works including the work created for Outcome 1.

Weighting: This task is worth 15% (/20) of the overall semester grade **Time allocated to task:** 5 periods

Due: Term 2, Week 8

School assessed coursework for Unit 3 will contribute 30% towards the final grade.
