Time Allocation

This unit of work will consist of approximately 100 hours of which at least 50 hours will be class time. **To complete this unit of work satisfactorily, students must complete each of the following learning outcomes.**

Learning Outcomes

Outcome 1 Population Dynamics

The student should be able to analyse, describe and explain population dynamics on a global scale.

Outcome 2 Population Issues and Dynamics

The student should be able to analyse, describe and explain the nature of significant population issues and challenges in selected locations and evaluate responses.

Assessment Tasks

1 Analysis of Geographic Data: Factors Affecting Human Population

The student is required to complete a data analysis task on seen and unseen data relating to population.

Weighting: This task is worth 40% of the overall SAC grade **Time allocated to task:** 1 period
Due: **Term 3, Week 6**

2 Population issues and Responses

The student is required to complete a series of structured questions on significant population issues and challenges related to growing populations and ageing populations, and the responses to these issues.

Weighting: This task is worth 60% of the overall SAC grade **Time allocated to task:** 2 periods
Due: **Term 4, Week 1**

3 End of Year Exam

All of the key knowledge and skills that underpin the outcomes in Units 3 and 4 are examinable.

Weighting: This task is worth 50% of the overall year's grade **Time allocated to task:** 2 hours
