## VCE Unit 4 Health and Human Development

### Time Allocation

### Learning Outcomes

#### Outcome 1

The student should be able to analyse factors contributing to variations in health status between Australia and developing countries, and evaluate progress towards the United Nations' Millennium Development Goals.

#### Outcome 2

The student should be able to describe and evaluate programs implemented by international and Australian government and non-government organisations, and analyse the interrelationships between health, human development and sustainability.

### Assessment Tasks

#### 1. Global Health and Human Development

The student is required to describe and evaluate programs implemented by international and Australian government and non-government organisations, and analyse the interrelationships between health, human development and sustainability.

#### 2. Sustainable Development Goals

The student is required to discuss the role of the National Health Priority Areas in improving Australia's health status.

**Weighting:** This task is worth 25% Unit 3 course work      **Time allocated to task:** 1 period

**Due:** Term 3, Week 4

#### 3. Australian government and non-government organisations

The student is required to describe and evaluate programs implemented by international and Australian government and non-government organisations, and analyse the interrelationships between health, human development and sustainability.

**Weighting:** This task is worth 50% of Unit 3 course work      **Time allocated to task:** 2 periods

**Due:** Term 3, Week 8

#### 4. End of Year Examination

The student is required to apply knowledge and understanding of all the key knowledge and key skills that underpin the outcomes in Units 3 and 4.

**Weighting:** This task is worth 50% of the overall grade      **Time allocated to task:** 135 minutes
