Assessment Tasks

1. Global Health and Human Development

The student is required to describe and evaluate programs implemented by international and Australian government and non-government organisations, and analyse the interrelationships between health, human development and sustainability.

Weighting: This task is worth 50% of Unit 3 course work Time allocated to task: 2 periods

Due: Term 3, Week 8

4. End of Year Examination

The student is required to apply knowledge and understanding of all the key knowledge and key skills that underpin the outcomes in Units 3 and 4.

Weighting: This task is worth 50% of the overall grade **Time allocated to task**: 135 minutes
