## **VCE Unit 4 Product Design and Technology Textiles**

### **Time Allocation**

### **Learning Outcomes**

#### **Outcome 1**

The student should be able to compare, analyse and evaluate similar commercial products, taking into account a range of factors and using appropriate techniques.

#### **Outcome 2**

The student should be able to safely apply a range of production skills and processes to make the product designed in Unit 3, and manage time and resources effectively and efficiently.

#### **Outcome 3**

The student should be able to evaluate the outcomes of the design, planning and production activities, explain the product's design features to the client, and outline its care requirements.

### **Assessment Tasks**

#### **1 SAC 1**

The student is required to compare, analyse and evaluate similar commercial products, taking into account a range of factors and using appropriate techniques

**Weighting:** This SACs plus both from Unit 3 are worth, in total, 20% of the overall grade

**Time allocated to task:** 2 weeks

**Due:** Term 3, Week 1

#### **2 Complete the Production Product and Folio**

The student is required to safely apply a range of production skills and processes to make the product designed in unit 3, and manage time and resources effectively and efficiently. Also complete the remaining folio tasks.

**Weighting:** This task is worth 50% of the overall grade with folio **Time allocated to task:** Over Unit 3 and Unit 4

**Due:** Term 3, Week 7

#### **3 End of Year Exam**

All of the key knowledge and skills that underpin the outcomes in Units 3 and 4 are examinable.

**Weighting:** This task is worth 30% of the overall year's grade **Time allocated to task:** 1.5 hours
